Kids please ask your parent's permission before installing ShakerMod. ShakerMod includes a simulated earthquake experience. This includes how earthquakes feel and sound as you experience them. If you're worried about this, it might help to turn off the sound in the game's settings.

How do I install ShakerMod?

We have created two guides for you to [install ShakerMod](#). Look through the guide that matches the type of computer you are using.

How am I supposed to know what to do in ShakerMod?

We've created a [user guide](#) that gives you all the information you need.

I have previously played in ShakerMod, but now it's not working?

It could be that you are using an older version of ShakerMod. You will need to update to the newest version.

- [Download](#) the latest file to your computer
- Open the [Installation Guide](#) for Windows or Mac (depending on the computer you are using) and head to the '**Installing ShakerMod**' section
- Follow the directions to where you find your Minecraft Mod folder
- Delete the old Mod and copy and paste the new Mod file.

How do I turn off the Background Music?

It's simple, all you need to do is:

- Open the Minecraft game or press Esc if you are in the middle of playing
- On the homescreen click where it says **Options**
- On the right hand side click on **Music & Sounds**
- Slide the slider left until it reads **Music: OFF**

How do I turn off all Sounds in ShakerMod?

To turn off all the noise within ShakerMod you need to follow the first three steps above for **Turning off background music**. Then, Slide **Master Volume** down until it says **Master Volume: OFF**. This might be useful if you have someone that is concerned with the sound of earthquakes.

Can I play ShakerMod with my friends?

Yes! But you will need to set up a server. In your [Installation Guide for Mac or Windows](#), there's a section at the bottom called **Create your own server | Playing with friends**. Check it out, we've found a video with all the tips you need to get this up and running.

How do I create my own Earthquake Experiences in ShakerMod?

We've created a [User Guide](#) that gives you all the information you need to create your own earthquakes. It includes an explanation of what each special earthquake block does.

Can I view te Reo content in ShakerMod?

Yes you can! You can do this under your **Options / Language** you can then select whatever language you'd like. Note it can take a few seconds for it to select that language, it's not an instant switch.

How do I create my own earthquake?

Is ShakerMod available for iPad?

No, ShakerMod is currently only able to run on the Java version of Minecraft for both Windows and Mac.

Commands to play in Minecraft?

Not sure how to move around in Minecraft, here's a list of commonly used commands. A more [detailed breakdown](#) is also available.

To set gamemode

/gamemode 0 (survival)

/gamemode 1 (creative)

/gamemode 2 (adventure)

/gamemode 3 (spectator)

Mouse

The mouse controls turning and aiming.

Left Button

The left button is used hit things - i.e. to break blocks or attack an enemy. It will use the item you are using in your Main Hand.

Right Button

The right button is used for a lot of things:

- placing blocks
- using certain tools (hoeing farmland; shearing sheep)
- eating and drinking
- using the item in your off hand
- operating buttons and levers
- opening doors
- accessing containers (chests, furnaces, brewing stands, etc)

Keyboard controls

W	Forward
S	Backwards
A	Left
D	Right
Space	Jump
Shift	Sneak
E	Open the inventory
Q	Drop the item in your hand on the floor

Flying - In Creative Mode, double-tap the “Jump” key to fly. When flying, press “Jump” to move upwards and SHIFT to move downwards.
