



Tokelau is in the South Pacific Ocean, about halfway between Hawai'i and Aotearoa New Zealand.


Tokelau's geography is made up of low-lying coral atolls. These atolls are ring-shaped islands with a lagoon in the middle. The atolls of Tokelau sit on extinct volcanic peaks!

About 1,500 Tokelauans live on these atolls, but 7,000+ Tokelauans live in Aotearoa New Zealand.


In this activity book we're going to have some fun learning Tokelau kupu (words!)




This is the Tokelau *fuka*. Add colour in to finish it! Ko te *flag* tenei a Tokelau. Valivali ke fakauma.



The Tokelau flag shows a vaka sailing towards the Southern Cross constellation of stars.


Draw arrows from the words to the right part of the *tino*.




The Tokelau <u>alafapeta</u> has 15 letters. Match the words with the letters they start with.


